Jump outside. Warm clothes and gloves encouraged. Suede half-chaps are allowed but note - not in sanctioned divisions; smooth snaffles only for dressage. Jumping not timed.

- All dressage tests are in a small indoor arena and must be ridden from memory. Organizers reserve right to cancel divisions with insufficient entries. Divisions will be divided Junior/Senior if entries warrant.

DOGS Stone Place Stables requests that visitors do not bring outside dogs - posted at entrance.
